Scholarship Guidelines and Instructions

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be an African-American high school senior who is a resident of Fairfax County, VA or Washington, DC.
- Demonstrate strong academic standing with a **minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0**.
- Graduate from an accredited secondary educational institution in Spring 2022.
- Plan to enter a four-year college or university as a full-time freshman in Fall 2022.
- Demonstrate community service experience.
- *NOTE: Children of members of Jack and Jill of America, Inc. are ineligible to apply.*

HOW TO APPLY

Application submissions must include the following:

- A complete and signed Scholarship Application.
- A one-page typewritten personal essay (Times New Roman 12-point font, double-spaced with Applicant Name in header).
- A digital color photo (.jpg, .gif, .png format). Do not submit proofs or personality photos.
- An official academic transcript with cumulative grade point average for Grades 9-11 and all available senior year grades.
- A signed 2021-2022 letter of recommendation from a current teacher, school counselor, or principal prepared on school letterhead and submitted as a .PDF.

APPLICATION DEADLINE AND SUBMISSION

The completed and signed application package must be submitted via email to JJRestonScholarship@gmail.com by 11:59 p.m. (Eastern) on **May 13, 2022**. Incomplete submissions will not be considered. Applicants are responsible for ensuring their transcript and letter of recommendation are submitted on time.

AWARD NOTIFICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship awardees will be notified of their selection as a scholarship recipient in late June 2022. All awardees must provide the Scholarship Committee with a copy of their acceptance letter and student identification number for the college or university where they will enroll in the Fall of 2022; this information must be submitted by August 31, 2022.
